

Day 1-Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport (UB city), meet **Samar Magic Tours team**. Ulaanbaatar Grand City tour. (L)

Day 2-The 40 meter/~133,3 feet Genghis Khan Statue-Gorkhi/Terelj National Park-Ulaanbaatar. (B)(L)

Day 3-Ulaanbaatar-Bagazarin Chuluu (Rock Formations) in Middle Gobi. (B)(L)(D)

Day 4-Tsagaan Tsuvarga (Stupas or White Pagodas) in Middle Gobi. (B)(L)(D)

Day 5-Tsagaan Tsuvarga-Gobi Desert-Yolin Canyon. (B)(L)(D)

Day 6-Gobi Desert: Hongor Largest Sand Dunes-True Camel Family-Camel Riding. (B)(L)(D)

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:


Day 1-Upon your arrival in **Ulaanbaatar** ``**Genghis Khan**´´ **New Airport** and after custom formalities and baggage claim, you will be met by **Samar Magic Tours team** and taken to the centrally located hotel in Ulaanbaatar (*by hotels policy the check-in time is after **02:00PM/14:00**). **Ulaanbaatar Grand City Tour**: visit the **Gandantegchinlen Monastery** is a Tibetan-style Buddhist monastery that has been restored and revitalized since 1990. The Tibetan name translates to the **"Great Place of Complete Joy"**. It currently has over 150 monks

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
in residence. It features a 26.5-meter-high statue of Avalokitesvara. It came under state protection in 1994. **10:00AM**-Here you will have the opportunity to attend a Buddhist ceremony. Next, we will visit a small museum of dinosaur fossils. The centerpiece of the museum is the 4m-tall, 3-ton ultraviolet Tarbosaurus bataar (cousin of Tyrannosaurus rex) and a smaller Saurolophus, with its distinctive cranial crest. The Tarbosaurus bataar made international headlines in 2012, when it sold for more than US\$1 million at an auction in Texas. The Mongolian Government protested that the fossil had been illegally removed from Mongolia and demanded its return. The legal battle ended when a US judge ruled in favor of Mongolia. Nicolas Cage has agreed to return a rare dinosaur skull to the Mongolian government. The Oscar-winning actor bought the Tyrannosaurus bataar skull in 2007, not knowing it had been stolen. Authorities said he voluntarily agreed to hand over the skull after learning of the circumstances. The museum also includes examples of Velociraptor and Protoceratops, and a nest of Oviraptor eggs. It is located inside the former Lenin Museum, built in 1974. While there are plans to expand it into a world-class institution. Visit the National History Museum-where you will see artefacts from Mongolia and Central Asia from the Stone Age to the present. Here you will see a large statue of the Genghis Khan-inaugurated in 2006 on the occasion of 800th Anniversary of the Great Mongolian Empire of Genghis Khan (1206-2006), the Sukh Baatar Hero along with The Parliament House, Stock Exchange, the Drama Theatre and the Palace of Culture. Welcome lunch in traditional local restaurant. Next, visit the New Museum "Genghis Kan" ("Chinggis Khaan"), opened in the month of Octubre-2022. The museum is designed to show the history of the Mongol kings from the reign of King Hunnu Modun Shanyu to the abdication of the Eighth Jebtsundamba. Transfer to hotel. 06:00PM-Mongolian National Performers (concert which includes the Tsam dance, traditional Mongolian singers, dancers, Tuvan throat singing and contortionists). Transfer to hotel. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. **Dinner is not included**. (L)

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Day 2-Breakfast. **09:00AM**-Meet Samar Magic Tours team at reception of the hotel. Drive towards to visit the **40meter /~133,3 feet Genghis Khan Statue on horseback** (55km/34mi) N/E of the Mongolian capital Ulaanbaatar. The statue is symbolically pointed east towards his birthplace. It is on top of the **Genghis Khan Statue Complex**, a visitor center, itself 10 meters (32 ft 10 in) tall, with 36 columns representing the 36 khans from **Genghis** to Ligdan Khan. Visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. Near the Great Statue of **Genghis Khan**, we can take beautiful photos with **the Kazakhs and their Golden Eagles**, **rides on the backs of Bactrian camels**, **or rides on Mongolian horses** through the steppes, **shooting with a bow and arrow** (***extra payment at the same place**). **Mongolian lunch is included on the way**. After, continuous drive north further to reach

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Gorkhi/Terelj National Park. Seeing grasslands and beautiful vistas. The valley is about 20kms/12miles long at 1600m. This picturesque National Park is a part of **Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area**. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. Explore the **Turtle shaped original giant rock** - symbol of Gorkhi/Terelj National Park. Walking & Easy Trekking to **Arryabal Meditation Temple**, on the top of the small hill. **Drive back to Ulaanbaatar**. Transfer to hotel. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. **Dinner is not included**. **(B)(L)**





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Day 3-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team at reception of the hotel. Drive towards by comfortable 4WD vehicle to **Baga Gazariin Chuluu** – located in Delgertsogt sum, Dundgovi province and surrounded by plain. The highest one is 15 km long and 10 km wide granite stone-mountain elevated at 1768m above sea level. You will see rocks and stones in unique shapes and buries of Mongols from middle ages. On the way, we explore **the ruins of Sum Khukh Burd Temple**. It was built in the 10th century from rocks transported from over 300kms/187 miles away. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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




Day 4-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive towards to **Tsagaan Tsuvarga White Stupas or White Pagodas**, about 280 km/174 miles), 6 hours drive from the **Bagazarin Chuluu (Rock Formations)**. **Tsagaan Tsuvarga (Stupas or White Pagodas)** are located approximately 426 km (265 miles) from Ulaanbaatar, and 30 km east of the main road Ulaanbaatar - Umnugobi (Gobi South). The 30-60 m (196.85 ft) high, 400 m (1312.34 ft) long, colorful limestone formation was once the ocean floor where visitors find marine fossils and shells. Its colors stand out in the morning and at night. Tsagaan Suvarga got its name because its shape resembles relict Buddhist stupas or pagodas. There are some trails to walk down and up through the cliffs. Opportunity to photograph its colors in the morning and at night. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 5-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive to **Gobi Desert** in South Gobi province via Dalanzadgad the southernmost city with only some 300 kms/187 miles from Chinese border. Drive directly to explore **Yolin Canyon** on foot in **Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park**-was established in 1993, and expanded to its current size in 2000. This is the largest national park in Mongolia. Famed for its rich bird habitat, **Yoliin Canyon or commonly known as (Vulture's Gorge)** was originally established as a bird preserve and later for its stunning beauty and great hiking options Yoliin Canyon became one of the major destinations in Gobi. There is a small museum, which displays dinosaur eggs, some bones and stuffed birds and leopards. Here you will have the opportunity for **hiking in the ice valley of Gobi**, the stunning landscapes. Here you will have the opportunity to **rides on Mongolian horses** through the **Yoliin Canyon Valley of Gobi** (***extra payment at the same place**). Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 6-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Today, a long trip towards to **Hongor Largest Sand dunes**. **Exploration and enjoy and climb up** to over 200 m high **Khongoryn els (Singing sand dunes)**. At the north end of the dune, it has formed a beautiful oasis where they grow grass and flowers, so it is nice to see vegetation in the desert. **Visit an authentic camel breeding family**. **See their real nomadic life and ride two humped camels around picturesque desert oasis Khongor river**. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**



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Day 7-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive towards to Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffs in Gobi desert. Explore Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffshere Roy Chapman Andrews, an American palaeontologist and staff of the Museum of Natural History in New York first found 4-6 inches dinosaur eggs here in 1922. Bayanzag is referred as Flaming Cliffs for its amazing colours and shape). Enjoy the Gobi sunset at the legendary "Flaming Cliffs," which glow brilliantly at sunrise and sunset. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. (B)(L)(D)

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
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Day 8-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long trip towards north, to reach the ruins of

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
Ongi temple-the unique 17th century sole monastery at the heart of the desert. **Ongiin khiid** (also referred as **Ongi Monastery ruins**) is an active small monastery with a temple which was built on the ruins of a monastery com plex that was formerly one of the largest monasteries in Mongolia and founded in 1760 and consisted of two separate temples com plexes, Barlim khiid and Khutagt khiid, on the North and South of the Ongi Gol river. Here there is an opportunity to enjoy and relax in the




SAUNA or MASSAGE (***pay directly on site!**). In the evenings, cultural and entertainment programs are sometimes offered. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 9-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Today, we will head North to **Orkhon Waterfall.** The **Orkhon river** derives its name from the Old Turkic prefix "or" meaning "middle", and "khan" or king. It rises in the **Khangai Mountains** in the Tsenkher sum (local town) of Arkhangai province at the foot of the Suvraga Khairkhan mountain. From there, it crosses the border into Uvurkhangai province and follows the upper Orkhon valley in an eastern direction until it reaches Karakorum. On this stretch, very close to the **Orkhon, the Ulaan Tsutgalan river** features a **waterfall**, ten metres (33 ft) wide and twenty metres (66 ft) high, which is a popular destination for tourists. With 1,124 km (698 mi), the Orkhon is longer than the Selenge, making it the longest river in Mongolia. **UNESCO** lists the **Orkhon Valley** as a **World Heritage Site. Free time in your own.** Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 10-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Today, we will head North to **Karakorum in Central Mongolia-the Genghis (Chinggis) Khan's 13th century capital and heart of the mighty Mongolian Empire and Okhon river Valley, cradle of Mongolian civilization**. Visitors, such as **Marco Polo**, described its ornate building, including a 2500 sq. meters Palace of Worldly Peace. Next, we will visit the **Monument to the Mongol States** located on a hill overlooking the city of **Karakorum (Kharkhorin)**, on the bank of the **Orkhon River**. It was built in 2004. The monument consists of a large pile of stones (**a shamanic ovoo**) carefully assembled into a cone shape, approximately the same size as a tipi, with nine posts protruding from the top. This structure is mounted on a stone and concrete platform and is surrounded by three walls that



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represent three sections of a circle. The outer sides of these walls feature three colorful mosaics representing three maps, one for each of the empires.

1. First, there was the **Xiongnu Empire**, a confederation of nomadic tribes that lived on the steppes from about the 3rd century BC. until the 1st century AD.

2. The **Turkish Khaganate Empire** followed, established by the Göktürks in 682 and lasting only until 744.

3. Finally, and famously, **Genghis Khan** founded the **Mongol Empire** of the 13th and 14th centuries.

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The iconic place of the Mongol Empire in culture, combined with the shamanic symbolism of the ovoo at the center of the monument, prompts people to leave offerings of vodka, milk, tea, rice and other edible delicacies that inevitably attract birds and some than another herd of goats and sheep passing by. You can also find several animal skulls around the monument, completing the surreal scene. It is no coincidence that the Monument of The Imperial Map is located in Kharkhorin, as this city (then called Karakorum) was the capital of the Mongol Empire under Genghis Khan's successor, Ogedei Khan. The Imperial Map Monument is a great vantage point from which to look out over the city of Kharkhorin and the Orkhon River, and imagine what this collection of dirt roads and low-rise buildings may have looked like in its glory days. Also, today, we will visit to the

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legendary Erdene zuu (Hundred Treasures) Monastery, the Turtle monument, and the Karakorum museum, to see the relics of the ancient capital of the Mongol Empire. The Erdene Zuu Buddhist Monastery with its 108 stupas and the first Buddhist Lamasery (16th century) was the most important religious seat. Currently it constitutes an impressive sight, with its walls, stupas and temples, occupying an enclosure of 400 square meters, and surrounded by the steppe. The construction was continued by his son 'Ogedei' Khan, after his death. After 40 years, 'Kublai Khan' (grandson of Genghis Khan and host of Marco Polo) moved the capital of the Empire to Beijing (Peking-Yuan dynasty), already invaded. In the year 1792, there were 62 temples left and more than 10,000 Lamas. In the year 1930, the Stalinist purges destroyed most of their temples and the Lamas were banished to die in Siberia. Of its more than one hundred temples, only three have survived to our era, it remains the most outstanding cultural vestige of Mongolia. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp in Karakorum. (B)(L)(D)



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





Day 11-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Departure to the **Tsenkher Hot Springs** (120 km/75 miles, about 2.30hrs), located near the **Khangai mountains** and in a forested area, in the province of Arkhangai. These hot springs are sulphurous springs that flow at a temperature of more than 80 degrees, allowing visitors **to enjoy an open-air spa in the middle of nature**. These waters are appreciated for their healing properties. In this area there is a presence of nomadic families where they graze with their herds of horses, yaks, sheep, bulls, etc. Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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


Day 12-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long drive towards via **Tsetserleg city** to **Khorgo a dormant volcano and Lake Terkhiin Tsagaan National Park**. On the way, stop to **hike to Khorgo-a dormant volcano**. As you **hike up the Khorgo Dead Volcano**, the dramatic scenery of the beautiful alpine lake to the west and volcanic lava flows to the east will open in front of you. **Terkhiin Tsagaan Nuur**-this is a freshwater lake with volcanic area around **it is certainly the highlight of Arkhangai province**. Here you will have the opportunity for hiking around the lake. **Explore the area on foot**. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 13-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive towards to reach **Lake (Nuur) Zuun**. A perfect stop over for travellers. **Zuun Nuur Lake** is situated about 2000 meters above sea level and it can be really cold (below 13 degrees) in the evening even during summer time. It is **a salt water lake** and it's so exclusive that it is not even marked on the google map!. Here you will have the opportunity for hiking around the lake. **Explore the area on foot**. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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




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Day 14-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive along **Hangai Mountains** via **Murun** towards to **Lake Huvsgul National Park-**known as **blue pearl of Mongolia**, located close to the Siberian border. Stop in-route in the **Valley of Kings** for the display of the ancient burial grounds of the Turkic nobles and a view of the carved "**Deer Stones**". **Deer Stone Monuments** were added to **UNESCO World Heritage List** (2023). This site is located 17km west from Murun town and about 3km from northern bank of Delger murun river. It is fascinating and interesting to see a complex of 30 deer stones and big Khirgisuur (Tomb) and slab burials. In terms of statue number, skillful works and illustrations, this complex sites are a great representation of this culture. Especially, statues with images of human face draw attention of many scientists and considered one of the rarest statues. **Lake Huvsgul** is the second largest freshwater lake in Central Asia. **Huvsgul** water is crystal fresh and clear that you can drink the water and see points at as deep a s 24.5m. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 15-Breakfast. **Free day and relaxation in Lake Huvsgul National Park**. Enjoy the view of the beautiful lake Khuvsgul, a crystal-clear water lake that stretches over 100 miles. **Explore the area on foot. See a Tsaataan (Reindeer) people. Optional activities** such as fishing, boating, horseback riding, sauna, birdwatching, etc (***optional payment on site!**). Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**



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Day 16- Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long drive towards to **Uran-Togoo Tulga Uul Natural Park** in Bulga province. **Explore the area of Uran extinct volcano on foot**. This area has been protected as a **"Natural Monument"** since 1965, and covers 58 square km. The protected area is the home of numerous kinds of rare animals. **Uran extinct volcano** is at an elevation of 1,686 meters above sea level. On the top is a crater with a small crater lake of about 20 meters in diameter. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

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Day 17-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive towards to reach **Amarbayasgalant monastery**. **Explore on foot, the monastery complex and statues on the mountain**. **Amarbayasgalant monastery** was originally built in 1737 by the Manchurian King Kansu, who dedicated it to the great Mongolian Buddhist and sculptor, **Zanabazar**. **Amarbayasgalant** was one of the greatest Buddhist pilgrimage centers where between the 17th and 19th Centuries about one thousand lamas lived, chanted and studied. In 1996, was designated as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**



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Day 18-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. **Return to Ulaanbaatar** (about 380km/236miles, +6hours drive, depending on the traffic at the entrance to Ulaanbaatar). **Latest purchases of Mongolian souvenirs and pure Mongolian cashmere.** Transfer to the hotel (*the rooms can be used after 2:00 p.m. on the day of arrival. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. **Dinner is not included. (B)(L)**

Day 19-Breakfast. The rooms must be vacated before **12 noon** on the day of departure. Meeting with Samar Magic Tours at the hotel reception. Transfer to Ulaanbaatar **``Genghis Khan**´´ New Airport. **Departure Mongolia (B). ALL OF MONGOLIA GRAND TOUR ENDS.**


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OUTSTANDING EXPERIENCES:

• Visit the Great Equestrian Statue of Genghis Khan. Near to the Great Statue of Genghis Khan, you can take beautiful photos with the Kazakhs and their Golden Eagles.

• Visit to the most beautiful Gorkhi/Terelj National Park, located in the N/E at 1600m above sea level, with high Mesozoic granitic rocks, mountains, steppes, alpine forests and large rock formations with curious Mesozoic shapes such as it is the rock of the Tortoise or the Monk Reading the Book, etc.

• We will walk through the dunes and we will be able to climb the highest peak that the nomads call "Singing Peak" because of the noise made by the wind, where we will be able to observe a wonderful landscape of sand dunes located in an oasis, surrounded by rocky mountains and we will enjoy the contrast of the Mongolian Gobi desert.

• We will visit an authentic family with Bactrian camel farms. We will get to know the Mongolian nomadic lifestyle.

• We will enjoy an excursion on the back of a Bactrian camel.

• Explore the monastery complex and statues on the mountain. Amarbayasgalant monastery was originally built in 1737 by the Manchurian King Kansu, who dedicated it to the great Mongolian Buddhist and sculptor, Zanabazar.

• Listen to the mesmerizing sounds of Khoomi throat singing during a traditional dance performance.
