The Best Time to Travel to Mongolia: The travel season begins in mid-May, when the tourist Gers camps start opening. July and August are the peaks tourist season. September is autumn.

Day-by-day Itinerary:

Day 1-Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar (UB or ULN), meet Samar Magic Tours team and transfer to your hotel. The check-in time at hotel is after **02:00P.M.** In the afternoon, City tour: visit the Genghis or Chinggis Khaan square-this is the main square in the heart of Ulaanbaatar. Here you will see a large statue of the Genghis or Chinggis Khaan-inaugurated in 2006 on the occasion of 800th Anniversary of the Great Mongolian Empire of Genghis Khan (1206-2006), the Sukh Baatar Hero along with The Parliament House, Stock Exchange, the Drama Theater and the Palace of Culture. Visit the National History Museum-where you will see artifacts from Mongolia and Central Asia from the Stone Age to the present. **06:00 P.M.**-National Performers (concert which includes the Tsam dance, traditional Mongolian singers, dancers, Tuvan throat singing and contortionists). Welcome dinner in local restaurant. Overnight at selected hotel. **(D)**

Day 2-In the early morning, visit the Gandantegchinlen Monastery is a Tibetan-style Buddhist monastery, that has been restored and revitalized since 1990. The Tibetan name translates to the "Great Place of Complete Joy". It currently has over 150 monks in residence. It features a 26.5-meter-high statue of Avalokitesvara. It came under state protection in 1994. Afterward, drive towards N/E to visit the 40 meter (~133,3 feet) Statue of Genghis or Chinggis Khaan. Visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. Continue north to Terelj National Park. The valley is about 20kms/10miles long at 1600m. This picturesque National Park is a part of Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. On the way, we explore the 100 Lamas cave, where 100 Lamas hide from the soviets repression. Explore on foot the Turtle shaped original giant rock. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 3-Next, drive south towards to Bagazarin Chuluu in Middle Gobi-this is 1768m high, 15km long, 10km wide rocky mountain and is perfect for short trekking and walks around the surrounding area. You will see rocks and stones in unique shapes and burials of Mongols from middle ages. Dinner and overnight in tourist Gers camp in Bagazarin Chuluu. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 4-Drive south towards the Yolyn Am Canyon or Valley of Vultures in Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park. On the way, we explore Sum Khukh Burd Temple. It was built in the 10th century from rocks transported from over 300kms away. The Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park was established in 1993, and expanded to its current size in 2000. This the largest national park in Mongolia. Afternoon, you will have the opportunity for hiking in the ice valley of Gobi, the stunning landscapes. There is a small museum, which displays dinosaur eggs, some bones and stuffed birds and leopards. Explore the area on foot. Dinner and overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 5-A long trip towards to Hongor Largest Sand dunes in Gobi desert. Arrive and to be transferred. Afternoon, exploration and enjoy and climb up to over 200 m high Khongoryn els (Singing sand dunes) and ride two humped camels around picturesque desert oasis Khongor river. Overnight in tourist Gers camp in Hongor sand dunes. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 6-Drive towards to Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffs in South Gobi desert. Explore Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffs-here Roy Chapman Andrews, an American paleontologist and staff of the Museum of Natural History in New York first found 4-6 inches dinosaur eggs here in 1922. The large dinosaur skeletons placed at the Museum of Natural History in Ulaanbaatar was also found here by a Russian-Mongolian expedition. Bayanzag is referred as Flaming Cliffs for its amazing colors and shape). Enjoy the Gobi sunset at the legendary "Flaming Cliffs," which glow brilliantly at sunrise and sunset. Dinner and overnight in tourist Gers camp in Bayanzag. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 7-A long trip towards north to reach Ongi Temple-the unique 17th century sole monastery at the heart of the desert. Ongiin khiid (also referred as Ongi Monastery ruins) is an active small monastery with a temple which was built on the ruins of a monastery complex that was formerly one of the largest monasteries in Mongolia and founded in 1760 and consisted of two separate temples complexes, Barlim khiid and Khutagt khiid, on the North and South of the Ongi Gol river about 18 km from Saikhan-Ovoo sub-provincial center, Dungobi (middle) province. Dinner and overnight in tourist Gers camp in Middle Gobi. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 8-Continue north to Karakorum-the Genghis (Chinggis) Khan's 13th century capital and heart of the mighty Mongolian Empire and Okhon river Valley, cradle of Mongolian civilization. During the trip, you will also have opportunities to visit a local nomadic family on the way. Visitors, such as Marco Polo, described its ornate building, including a 2500 sq. meters Palace of Worldly Peace. In 1792 the Monastery still had 62 temples and 10,000 lamas. But in 1930 it became a victim of the Stalin's purges. All but three of the Temples were destroyed and most of the monks were either killed or sent to Siberia. Now there is a museum and restored. Erdene Zuu monastery retains much of its ancient glory and is well worth visiting. Free time in Orkhon Valley. Meeting nomadic people. Today, the cultural heritage of the valley constitutes a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 9-In the morning, visits Erdene zuu monastery, the turtle monument and the museum. In the afternoon, drive further northwest to reach Tsenkher hot springs, situated in a mountain meadow. Relaxing and enjoy baths at Tsenkher hot Spa (89C/192.2F). Visit a Yak breeder's family and experience the traditional customs and lifestyle of local residents. Great opportunities for nature lovers to hike and optional horse ride. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 10-A long drive northwest towards via Tsetserleg city to Khorgo a dormant volcano and Lake Terkhiin Tsagaan National Park. On the way, stop to visit Taikhar rock-is situated at the south bank of Tamir River. Terkhiin Tsagaan Nuur-this is a freshwater lake with volcanic area around it is certainly the highlight of Arkhangai province. As you hike up the volcano, the dramatic scenery of the beautiful alpine lake to the west and volcanic lava flows to the east will open in front of you. Explore the area on foot. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 11-Drive north to reach Jargalant hot springs. A perfect stop over for travelers heading north to Lake Khovsgol. Enjoy the hot spa. Overnight in Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 12-Drive along Hangai Mountains via Murun towards to Lake Huvsgul National Park-known as blue pearl of Mongolia, located close to the Siberian border. Stop in-route in the Valley of Kings for the display of the ancient burial grounds of the Turkic nobles and a view of the carved "Deer Stones". Lake Huvsgul is the second largest freshwater lake in Central Asia. Huvsgul water is crystal fresh and clear that you can drink the water and see points at as deep as 24.5m. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 13-Free day and relaxation in Lake Huvsgul National Park. Enjoy the view of the beautiful lake Khuvsgul, a crystal clear water lake that stretches over 100 miles. Explore the area on foot. Optional activities such as fishing, boating, horseback riding, sauna, birdwatching, etc (*optional payment on site!). Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 14-A long drive towards to Uran-Togoo Tulga Uul Natural Park in Bulga province. Explore the area of Uran extinct volcano on foot. This area has been protected as a "Natural Monument" since 1965, and covers 58 square km. The protected area is the home of numerous kinds of rare animals. Uran extinct volcano is at an elevation of 1,686 meters above sea level. On the top is a crater with a small crater lake of about 20 meters in diameter. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 15-Drive towards to reach Amarbayasgalant monastery. Explore on foot, the monastery complex and statues on the mountain. Amarbayasgalant monastery was originally built in 1737 by the Manchurian King Kansu, who dedicated it to the great Mongolian Buddhist and sculptor, Zanabazar. Amarbayasgalant was one of the greatest Buddhist pilgrimage centers where between the 17th and 19th Centuries about one thousand lamas lived, chanted and studied. In 1996, was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 16-Drive back to Ulaanbaatar. Arrive and transfer to hotel. Shopping for souvenirs and cashmere. Farewell dinner at local restaurant. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 17-Breakfast. Transfer. Departure Mongolia. **(B). End of our services.**
