

Tour Highlights: Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport (52 kms/33.2 miles), meet Samar Magic Tours team. Natural Treasures of Northern and Central Mongolia gets you from Grasslands to the Great Khuvsgul Lake National Park in the Far Northern of Mongolia (close to Siberia) and to the All Highlights of Central Mongolia. Enjoy the view of the beautiful lake Khuvsqul, a crystal clear water lake that stretches over 100 miles. Explore the area on foot or on horseback. See a Tsaataan (Reindeer) people. Ride on a reindeer. Here, you will have the opportunity to do several optional activities. Lake Khuvsgul-is the largest fresh water lake in Mongolia by volume, and it is located in the northwest of Mongolia, near the Russian border, at the foot of the eastern Sayan Mountains. It is 1,645 metres (5,397 feet) above sea level, 136kms (85 miles) long and 262 metres (860 feet) deep. It is the second- most voluminous freshwater lake in Asia, and holds almost 70% of Mongolia's fresh water and 0.4% of all the fresh water in the world and second largest by area. The Park is home to a variety of wildlife such as ibex, argali, elk, wolf, wolverine, musk deer, brown bear, Siberian moose, and sable. Khuvsgul Lake was added to UNESCO World Network of Biosphere Reserves. The decision was made during the 34th session of the International Co-ordinating Council of the Man and the Biosphere Programme taking place in Paris, France. We would be pleased to have you join us!

The Best Time to Travel to the Northern of Mongolia: June, July and August are the peaks tourist season. September is autumn.

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**DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:** 

Day 1-Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport and after custom formalities and baggage claim, you will be met by Samar Magic Tours team and taken to the centrally located hotel in Ulaanbaatar (by hotels policy the check-in time is after 02:00PM/14:00). Ulaanbaatar City Grand Tour: visit the Gandantegchinlen Monastery is a Tibetan-style Buddhist monastery that has been restored and revitalized since 1990. The Tibetan name translates to the "Great Place of Complete Joy". It currently has over 150 monks in residence. It features a 26.5-meter-high statue of Avalokitesvara. It came under state protection in 1994. Here you will have the opportunity to attend a Buddhist ceremony. Next, we will visit a small museum of dinosaur fossils. The centerpiece of the museum is the 4m tall, 3 tonne UV light Tarbosaurus bataar (cousin of Tyrannosaurus rex) and a smaller Saurolophus, with its distinctive skull crest. The Tarbosaurus bataar made international headlines in 2012, when it sold for more than US\$1 million at auction in Texas. The Mongolian government protested that the fossil had been illegally removed from Mongolia and demanded its return. The legal battle ended when a US judge ruled in favor of



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Mongolia. The museum also includes examples of Velociraptor and Protoceratops, and a nest of Oviraptor eggs. It is located inside the former Lenin Museum, built in the year 1974. While there are plans to expand it into a world-class institution. Visit the **National History Museum**-where you will see artefacts from Mongolia and Central Asia from the Stone Age to the present. Here you will see a large statue of the **Genghis Khan**-inaugurated in 2006 on the occasion of 800th Anniversary of the Great Mongolian Empire of **Genghis Khan** (1206-2006), the **Sukh Baatar Hero** along with The Parliament House, Stock Exchange, the Drama Theatre and the Palace of Culture. **Welcome lunch in traditional local restaurant.** Next, visit the **New Museum "Genghis Kan"** ("Chinggis Khaan"), opened in the month of Octubre 11, 2022. The museum is designed to show the history of the Mongol kings from the reign of King Hunnu Modun Shanyu to the abdication of the Eighth Jebtsundamba. **06:00PM**-Evening National Performers (concert which includes the Tsam dance, traditional Mongolian singers, dancers, Tuvan throat singing and contortionists). Transfer to hotel. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. **Dinner is not included.** (L)



Day 2-Breakfast. 08:00AM-Meet Samar Magic Tours team at reception of the hotel. Drive towards by comfortable 4WD vehicle to reach Amarbayasgalant monastery (360 km /224 miles north of Ulaanbaatar in the Baruunburen soum of Selenge province). Explore on foot, the monastery complex and statues on the mountain. Amarbayasgalant monastery was originally built in 1737 by the Manchurian King Kansu, who dedicated it to the great Mongolian Buddhist and sculptor, Zanabazar. The valley is covered throughout its extent with Turkic-era graves of various geometric shapes marked out in large boulders. These important archaeological features which date from the 3rd-7th centuries are the indication that the valley has long-standing sacred associations for the people of Mongolia, associations which continued and uninterrupted into the Buddhist era when they were re-validated by the construction of Amarbayasgalant Monastery on this historic site. Amarbayasgalant was one of the greatest Buddhist pilgrimage centers where between the 17th and 19th Centuries about one thousand lamas lived, chanted and



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studied. In 1996, was designated as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Originally, **Amarbayasgalant Monastery** consisted of over 40 temples built on the special terrace, surrounded by a wall, measuring 207x175 m. Only 28 temples now remain, they have been under State protection since 1944. The monastery has a symmetrical construction. According to which the buildings are hierarchically arranged along the central axis so that all the important buildings run down the centre to north and south. This layout of the Monastery is similar to the general layout of Manchu-style spatial planning of Imperial Palace but stylistically its art has tributary Chinese architectural influences. The size of its Tsogchin (Main) temple is 32x32 m. Its construction expresses the planning features of the Mongolian national architecture and engineering solutions are very original. One of the interesting solutions is routing of roof water through the inside of four columns, under the floor, through stone grooves and away from the Tsogchin temple. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 






Day 3-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Next, drive towards to Uran-Togoo Tulga Uul Natural Park in Bulgan province. Explore the area of Uran extinct volcano on foot. This area has been protected as a "Natural Monument" since 1965, and covers 58 square km. The protected area is the home of numerous kinds of rare animals. Uran extinct volcano is at an elevation of 1,686 meters above sea level. On




the top is a crater with a small crater lake of about 20 meters in diameter. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)



Day 4-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long trip via Murun towards to the Great Lake Khuvsgul National Park-known as blue pearl of Mongolia, located close to the Siberian border. Stop in-route in the Valley of Kings for the display of the ancient burial grounds of the Turkic nobles and a view of the carved "Deer Stones". Khuvsgul is the second largest freshwater lake in



Central Asia. Khuvsgul water is crystal fresh and clear that you can drink the water and see points at as deep as 24.5m. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)





Day 5-Breakfast. A free day and relaxation in Khuvsgul Lake National Park. Enjoy the view of the beautiful lake Khovsgol, a crystal clear water lake that stretches over 100 miles. Explore the area on foot. See a Tsaataan (Reindeer) people. Optional activities such as ride on a reindeer, ride horses on the steppes, fishing, boating, sauna, etc (extra payment on site!). Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)



**Day 6**-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long drive towards via Murun & **Khangai mountains**, towards to reach **Lake (Nuur) Zuun**. A perfect stop over for travellers. **Zuun Nuur Lake** is situated about 2000 meters above sea level and it can be really cold (below 13 degrees) in the evening even during summer time. It is a salt water lake and it's so exclusive that it is not even marked on the google map!. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 

Day 7-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive towards to Lake Terkhiin Tsagaan-Khorgo Extinct Volcano National Park-this is a freshwater lake with volcanic area around it is certainly the highlight of Arkhangai province. As you hike up the volcano, the dramatic scenery



of the beautiful alpine lake to the west and volcanic lava flows to the east will open in front of you. Explore the area on foot. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)



Day 8-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. A long drive towards via Tsetserleg city to reach Tsenkher Hot Springs, situated in a mountain meadow. Relaxing and enjoy baths at Tsenkher Hot Spa (89C/192.2F). Visit a Yak breeder's family and experience the traditional customs and lifestyle of local residents. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)





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**Day 9-**Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Continue our great journey to **Karakorum-the Genghis (Chinggis) Khan's 13th century capital and heart of the mighty Mongolian Empire** and Okhon river Valley, cradle of Mongolian civilization. Visitors, such as **Marco Polo**, described its ornate building, including a 2500 sq. meters Palace of Worldly Peace. In 1792 the Monastery still had 62 temples and 10,000 lamas. But in 1930 it became a victim of the Stalin's purges. All but three of the Temples were destroyed and most of the monks were either killed or sent to Siberia. Now there is a museum and restored. Next, we will visit the **Monument to the Mongol States** located on a hill overlooking the city of **Karakorum (Kharkhorin)**, on the bank of the Orkhon River. It was built in 2004. The monument consists of a large pile of stones (a shamanic ovoo) carefully assembled into a cone shape, approximately the same size as a tipi, with nine posts protruding from the top. This structure is mounted on a stone and concrete platform and is surrounded by three walls that represent three sections of a circle. The outer sides of these walls feature three colorful mosaics representing three maps, one for each of the empires.



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1. First, there was the Xiongnu Empire, a confederation of nomadic tribes that lived on the steppes from about the 3rd century BC. until the 1st century AD.

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- 2. The Turkish Khaganate Empire followed, established by the Göktürks in 682 and lasting only until 744.
- 3. Finally, and famously, Genghis Khan founded the Mongol Empire of the 13th and 14th centuries.

The iconic place of the **Mongol Empire** in culture, combined with the shamanic symbolism of the ovoo at the center of the monument, prompts people to leave offerings of vodka, milk, tea, rice and other edible delicacies that inevitably attract birds and some than another herd of goats and sheep passing by. Several animal skulls can also be found around the monument, completing the surreal scene. It is no coincidence that the Imperial Map Monument is located in Kharkhorin, as this city (then called Karakorum) was the capital of the Mongol Empire under Genghis Khan's successor, Ogedei Khan. The Imperial Map Monument is a great vantage point from which to look out over the city of Kharkhorin and the Orkhon River, and imagine what this collection of dirt roads and low-rise buildings may have looked like in its glory days. After, we visit the legendary Erdene zuu monastery, the turtle monument and the Karakorum museum, which is recently opened to show the public, remains unique in Kharakorum found during an excavation organized by Mongolia and Germany together. In 1792 the Monastery still had 62 temples and 10,000 lamas. But in 1930 it became a victim of the Stalin's purges. All but three of the Temples were destroyed and most of the monks were either killed or sent to Siberia. Subsequently the Orkhon Valley was continuously occupied throughout the Prehistoric and Bronze ages and in proto-historic and early historic times was settled successively by the Huns, Turkic peoples, the Uighurs, the Kidans, and finally the Mongols. Today, the cultural heritage of the valley constitutes a UNESCO World Heritage Visits Erdene zuu monastery, the turtle monument and the Karakorum museum. Mongol lunch in included front Erdene zuu monastery. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)





**Day 10**-Breakfast. Meet Samar Magic Tours team. Drive to reach **Elsen Tasarkhai (Bayangobi Desert)**, is a part of the 80 km/50 miles long Mongol Els Sand Dunes and is located on about 280kms/174miles west from the capital Ulaanbaatar. The nature in this area is really spectacular and great for relaxing. During the trip, you will also have opportunities **to ride two-humped Bactrian camel (1hr** is included), walk on sand dunes, and walk and relax in beautifully serene nature. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 

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Day 11-Breakfast. Drive to Ulaanbaatar (about 280kms/174miles, 5-6 hrs driving). Arrive and Latest purchases of Mongolian souvenirs and pure Mongolian cashmere. Transfer to hotel (by hotels policy the check-in time is after 02:00PM/14:00). Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. (B)(L)

**Day 12**- Breakfast. The rooms must be vacated before **12 noon** on the day of departure. Meeting with Samar Magic Tours at the hotel reception. Transfer to Ulaanbaatar **"Genghis Kan"** (**"Chinggis Khaan"**) New Airport. **Departure Mongolia (B). Great Tour Ends.**
